This guide provides step-by-step instructions on how to watch a Google Live Stream video.


Watch a Google Live Stream

1. After you log in to your CPS account, click on the link your teacher gives you in Google Classroom, your email or in Hangout Chat.

NOTES:

- You must be logged in to your CPS account in order to access the Google Live Stream.
- If a student has never set up a CPS account, please click <u>here</u> for instructions on how the student can claim their account.
- If you forget your CPS password, click <u>here</u> for instructions on how to reset your password.


If the Google Live Stream has not started yet, you will see a message that reads, "Waiting for streaming to begin Please standby..." like the picture below.






When your teacher starts the Google Live Stream, you will see the screen below:

1. Click the Play button to start watching the live broadcast.



After you click **Play**, you will see the Google Live Stream video your teacher is presenting like the pictures below.

1. To stop and pause the Google Live Stream, click the **Stop** button.
